History

The Foundation for Hope Village is a 501 (c)(3) organization. It was founded by Bill and Lucille Williams in 1967 when they sought care for their daughter, Sally, who had been diagnosed as an infant with an intellectual disability. Dissatisfied with the few services available for their daughter throughout the state, Mrs. Williams became the driving force behind the planning and building of Hope Village. She sought to create a place that would be a loving home for her daughter and others with similar disabilities. The Village, which opened in 1970, is located in Friendswood, Texas on 18 acres of land donated by Louis and Hildegard Strey.

Our Programs

Full-time residential services are available to individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities and who meet the admission criteria.

The Developmental Center offers a variety of work opportunities and training for adults. This program is open to residents of Hope Village as well as adults who live in local communities.

Respite care is offered to children and adults on a first come, first served basis. All participants must be current day program participants at Hope Village.

Before and after school care is also available as space allows for children who meet admission criteria.

We offer tours of Hope Village the first Tuesday of each month from 10:00 am - 11:00 am. If you are interested in applying for services with Hope Village, please schedule a tour by calling 281-482-7926.

Our Staff

Each of our five residences is independent, self-sufficient and has a caring staff dedicated to the Villagers 24 hours a day. Our staff cultivates the sense that residents are a part of a family by assisting each of them in reaching his or her full potential while providing loving support.

Staff members work with Villagers helping them set goals toward independence and offering guidance and encouragement so that they can become responsible, contributing members of the Hope Village family.

Our Facilities

Hope Village is a private facility which currently consists of five separate homes, each built in a different style resembling a neighborhood. One home is licensed to provide care for children as young as six years old. Our most recent home opened in 2002 and is dedicated to the Villagers who require a higher level of care and assistance. Each home is licensed by either the Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services (Facility ID#s 000-346, 000-347, 000-348, 100789) or the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (Facility ID# 17729). Hope Village has a 14,000 square foot Developmental Center which provides job training and employment opportunities for residents and day program participants. Along with the workshop space, the center also includes a ceramics manufacturing area, a gift shop, a fully equipped kitchen and

the Village Café.

Our latest addition is our 21,000 square foot Education & Community Building, which opened in April 2016. This addition allows us to expand our Day Program and also provides small group learning communities, a sensory room and a chapel. The large ballroom space allows us to host social events, plays, fundraisers and community sponsored events.

Day Program

In addition to being a full-time residential facility, Hope Village also has other programs for Villagers and day students. Our Developmental Center Program is a work program overseen by the U.S. Department of Labor and is designed to develop self-confidence, healthy work ethics and a sense of accomplishment. Villagers receive payment on a piece rate scale for each item they complete and each Villager participating in this program is periodically assessed for skill development and mastery. There are a variety of work opportunities for the resident and non-resident adults who participate in this program. We offer subcontracts consisting of packaging, sorting and light assembling; ceramic manufacturing; and gift shop and café duties. We also have many activities for our Villagers to take part in such as bowling, games, church services, parties, dances, exercise classes and swimming.
